Confirmation Week 10 Homework Assignment

Theme of the Week: What does it mean to be a disciple?

This week was week 3 of our Jesus unit. In the first week we looked at the life, ministry, and teaching of Jesus. Week 2 was examining the different meanings of the cross. This week we examined what it means to actually be a *disciple* (follower) of Jesus.

We often confuse BELIEF and DISCIPLESHIP. Belief implies something inward, while discipleship implies something active. It is outward and oftentimes difficult. To begin, brainstorm ideas about what words come to mind when you hear the word "disciple". Then, try to write a definition of "disciple" in the first section of the last page of this handout. You can use resources like the dictionary or a thesaurus as a help for this first part.

Then, complete these two activities to explore this idea further.

ACTIVITY #1: Scripture

1.) Knowing that our theme today is discipleship, we will spend some time today looking at scriptures that might give us some insight. Read both bible stories, then answer the questions with *at least* 1-2 sentences. After finishing both stories, rewrite your definition of discipleship in the "definition #2" box on the last page.

Mark 12:41-44:

- Why was the woman's gift worth more than those who put in a lot more money?
- What does the story (in your opinion) tell us about discipleship?

Acts 7:51-60:

- Are there ways that you stand up for your faith at home or in school? Example?
- If so, what is difficult about standing up for your faith?
- What does this story (in your opinion) tell us about discipleship?


ACTIVITY #2: Video

•	What do you think it means when Rob says "God believes in you." Do you believe that? Are you a disciple? If so, how? If not, do you want to be?
